

# THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE RESURRECTION OR, TRUTHS DEPENDENT UPON THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST EASTER SUNDAY: March 31, 2013

## INTRODUCTION:

The central doctrine of the Christian Church is the Resurrection of Christ. Everything that we believe is tied to that one Sunday morning.

- I. TRUTHS DEPENDENT UPON THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST
  - E. OUR EVANGELISM (FRUITFULNESS) (Rom. 7:4)
    - If there is no Salvation, then there is no need for Evangelism
    - 2000 years of preaching wasted.
  - A. OUR ASSURANCE OF SALVATION (Rom. 8:34; Heb. 7:25)
  - S. OUR SALVATION (Rom. 10:9-10; 4:24)

**Justification** To count righteous; to put into a right relationship (with God). (*PWS*)

- If Christ did not rise, then there is no Savior.
- T. THE TRIUMPH OF RIGHTEOUSNESS (Acts 17:31)
  - If there is no Resurrection, then Evil has won!
  - All of the wrongs that we face, all the injustice, will never be accounted for.
- E. OUR EFFECTIVENESS IN THE LORD'S WORK (Gal. 2:20)
  - If there is no Resurrection, then folks, we are alone in trying to do this work! All is in the flesh, for there is no risen Lord to have sent His Spirit!
- R. THE RESURRECTION OF OUR OWN BODIES

(John 14:19; 1 Cor. 15:20-23)

If there is no Resurrection ... every Christian funeral a joke!

- A. WHAT DIDN'T HAPPEN
  - 1. THE ROMANS DIDN'T MOVE THAT BODY
  - 2. THE JEWS DIDN'T MOVE THAT BODY
  - 3. THE DISCIPLES DIDN'T MOVE THAT BODY
- B. WHAT DID HAPPEN!
  - 1. A STONE ROLLED AWAY
  - 2. A GRAVE THAT WAS EMPTY
  - 3. ANGELS THAT SPOKE
  - 4. CLOTHES THAT WERE LAID OUT BY THEMSELVES.
  - 5. THE NAPKINS FOLDED, AND PUT BY ITSELF
  - 6. OVER 500 WITNESSES SAW HIM
  - 7. JEWS SCRAMBLED TO COVER THEMSELVES, CREATING STORIES BACKED UP BY BRIBES.
  - 8. UNBELIEVING FAMILY AND APOSTLES SUDDENLY FOUND FAITH.
  - 9. APOSTLES PREACHED ABOUT IT, AND NO ONE GAINSAID THEM.
  - 10 APOSTLES, DISCIPLES DIED FOR HIM!

- 4. OUR EFFECTIVENESS IN THE LORD'S WORK IS ASSURED BECAUSE HE INTERCEDES
- 5. THE TRIUMPH OF RIGHTEOUSNESS WILL OCCUR
- 6. THE RESURRECTION OF OUR OWN BODIES IS NO FANTASY (1 Thess. 4:13-18)
